From the Pastor

I want to share with you a piece of news. One of the ways the church is organized is the existence of deaneries. In Idaho there are six deaneries and many multi-parish activities take place at the deanery level. The bishop appoints the Dean, who is the head of the deanery. The church also has the Presbyteral Council, a group of priests elected by the priests who are the main advisors to the bishop. In this diocese we have a system where each deanery elects a priest to be on the Presbyteral Council and then the bishop appoints that person to also be dean -- which means in effect the priests elect the dean. These elections take place every five years.

Our dean and Presbyteral Council member has been Father Joe DaSilva, pastor at Risen Christ. But since he was recently appointed to be the Vicar General, he has had to resign as dean. There has been an election, and the priests of the West Central Deanery have elected me to the Presbyteral Council and the bishop has appointed me to be dean. This is a great honor and I appreciate the trust placed in me by my fellow priests.

This is the third time I have been dean, both of the other times during the 18 years I served at Sacred Heart Parish in the 1970s and 1980s. I was also a member of the Presbyteral Council and its chairperson during the years I served in the Diocese of Baker.

Quisiera compartir una noticia con ustedes. Unas de las formas de organizar la iglesia diocesana es lo que llamamos los decanatos. En la diócesis de Boise hay varias actividades que se llevan acabo al nivel decanato. El obispo elige al decano que es el líder del decanato. Además la diócesis tiene también un Consejo Presbiteral que esta formado por un grupo de sacerdotes elegidos por los mismos sacerdotes, y es el principal consejero del obispo. Y entonces el obispo designa a dicha persona también decano. Estas elecciones se llevan acabo cada cinco años.

Hasta ahora nuestro decano y miembro del Consejo Presbiteral era el Padre Joe DaSilva, Párroco de Cristo Resucitado. Pero como fue nombrado por el obispo para hacer su Vicario General tuvo que renunciar a ser decano. Hubo elecciones, y los sacerdotes del decanato Centro-Oeste me eligieron para ser el Consejo Presbiteral y el obispo me designo Decano. Este es un gran honor y agradezco la confianza que en mi han depositado mis hermanos sacerdotes.

Esta es la tercera vez que he sido decano. Las otras dos veces anteriores fueron durante mis 18 años que estuve al frente de la parroquia del Sagrado Corazón, Boise en los 80's y 70's. También fui un miembro del Consejo Presbiteral y su líder durante los años que estuve sirviendo en la Diócesis de Baker.
