RENOVATION UPDATE

- We have received approval from the Diocesan Building Commission for the Design and Development phase of the building project.
- We have a buyer for the Parish Rectory and are in final negotiations to complete the sales transaction. Potentially the Parish Office could move prior to June 1st.
- We are in final negotiations with the City of Boise regarding the sewer line and expect that project to be completed by August 1st.
- We have several offers on the Castle Drive property and expect the sale to be completed within in the next 60 days.
- We are planning the move from the current Parish Office to the Parish Center and are readying the new location for our arrival.
