La información siguiente fue tomada del "Nuestra Parroquia" edición de enero de 2006.

En junio de 2004, el Comité de Migraciones de la Conferencia Episcopal de Estados Unidos y la Red Católica de inmigración decidieron solicitar una reforma completa de las leyes de inmigración con énfasis especial en la legalización, que es una prioridad esencial de política pública para la Iglesia.

Como parte de la respuesta de la Iglesia, un grupo de diversas organizaciones católicas han decidido unirse a la campaña que esta ahora en fase de intensificación. Los objetivos principales de la campana son:

- Educar al público, especialmente a la comunidad católica y a los funcionarios públicos católicos sobre la enseñanza católica en temas de inmigración e inmigrantes.
- Crear una voluntad política favorable a la reforma de la inmigración.
- Realizar reformas legislativas y administrativas basadas en los principios articulados por los obispos.
- Organizar redes católicas para ayudar a los inmigrantes que tengan derecho a obtener los beneficios de las reformas.

Los obispos de Estados Unidos y México publicaron una carta pastoral conjunta que pide:

- Una amplia legalización de los indocumentados de todas las nacionalidades.
- Una reforma del sistema de inmigración basado en la familia que permita la reunificación rápida.
- Reforma del sistema de inmigración basado en el empleo para proporcionar caminos legales para los trabajadores.
- Restauración de las protecciones del proceso debido para los inmigrantes.

The following information was taken from the "Nuestra Parroquia" January, 2006 edition.

In June of 2004 the United Status Conference of Catholic Bishops Committee on Migration and the Catholic Legal Immigration Network resolved to make comprehensive immigration reform with special emphasis on legalization, a major public policy priority within the church.

As part of the church's response, a diverse group of Catholic organizations have decided to join the campaign. The campaign's primary objectives are:

- To educate the public, especially the Catholic community, including Catholic public officials, about church teaching on migration and immigrants.
- To create political will for positive immigration reform.
- To enact legislative and administrative reforms based on the principles articulated by the bishops, and
- To organize Catholic networks to assist qualified immigrants obtain the benefits of the reform.

U.S. and Mexican Catholic bishops issued a joint pastoral letter calling for:

- A broad based legalization of the undocumented of all nationalities.
- Reform of the family-based immigration system to allow reunification.
- Reform of the employment-based immigration system to provide legal pathways for workers.
- Restoration of due process protections for immigrants.

If you'd like to share your love of gardening with young Idahoans, consider becoming certified as a University of Idaho Junior Master Gardener facilitator this spring. The certification classes will begin Wednesday, March 29, and continue for six weeks through May 3. They'll be offered at two separate times—2 p.m. to 5 p.m. or 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.—at the Idaho Botanical Garden, 2355 N. Penitentiary Road. Non-Profit youth program organizers, Teachers, Master Gardeners, parents with green thumbs, YMCA and Scouts leaders or other youth organization leaders are "naturals" for the program. The certification process can improve gardening, youth development and teaching skills of any green-thumbed adult or teen. The program uses a dozen youth-gardening curricula to demonstrate ways to teach horticulture and environmental science concepts to children in grades 3-8. Cost is \$25 per person or \$60 with the Junior Master Gardener Leader Guide. Credit is also available. Scholarships are available for bilingual speakers.
