Esta semana quiero compartir con ustedes la celebración de un santo cuya vida puede servir de estímulo y de ejemplo para nuestra vida cristiana. El día 14 la Iglesia celebra la fiesta del mártir San Maximiliano María Kolbe. Nació el 8 de enero de 1894 en Zdunska-Wola, Polonia. Fue un sacerdote de los Frailes Franciscanos, ordenado en 1918. Fue hecho prisionero por los nazis y enviado a un campo de concentración, primero a Pawiak y luego a Auschwitz. La noche del 3 de agosto de 1941 escapa un prisionero de la misma sección asignada al Padre Maximiliano. En represalia, el comandante del campo ordena escoger a 10 prisioneros para ser ejecutados. Entre ellos estaba el sargento Franciszek Gajowniczek, casado y con hijos. El Padre Maximiliano, que no estaba dentro de la lista de los condenados, se ofrece a morir en lugar de su paisano. El comandante del campo acepta el cambio y condena al Padre Maximiliano a morir de hambre. Diez días después, al encontrarlo todavía vivo, los nazis le administran una inyección letal, el 14 de agosto de 1941. El Papa Pablo VI lo beatifica en 1973. Juan Pablo II lo canoniza en 1982 como Mártir de la Caridad, ante la presencia del hombre por quien el ahora santo ofreciera su vida..

This week I would like to share with all of you the celebration of a Saint whose life encourages and exemplifies our Christian life. On the 14th the Church celebrates the feast of martyr Saint Maximilian Mary Kolbe. He was born on the 8th of January of 1894 in Zdunska-Wola, Poland. He was a priest of the Franciscan monks, ordained in 1918. He was imprisoned by the Nazis and was sent to a concentration camp, first to Pawiak and then to Auschwitz. The night of August 3rd of 1941 a prisoner escaped from the same section assigned to Father Maximilian. In retaliation, the commanding officer of the camp gave orders to pick 10 prisoners to be executed. Among them was a Sergeant Franciszek Gajowniczek, who was married and had children. Father Maximilian, who was not on the list of those to be punished, offered to die in place of his fellow countryman. The commanding officer accepted the switch and sentenced Father Maximilian to starve to death. Ten days after, upon finding him still alive, the Nazis administered a lethal injection, on the 14th of August, 1941. Pope Paul VI beautified him in 1973. Pope John Paul II canonized him in 1982 as Martyr of Charity, in the presence of the man for which the now saint offered his life for.

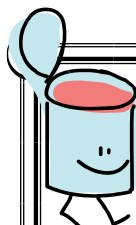
