From the Pastor

We will begin construction on the renewal of our church just after the first of the year. Before that time we will need to raise as much money as possible and you will obviously be hearing more about that as summer turns into fall. I am very optimistic at this point that all the pieces will finally fit together.

As we talk more about all of this, members of the parish community are coming forward with interesting ideas about some fund raising possibilities. The idea of a Garden Tour has been brought up, as well as a big car raffle, and an overseas cruise. Some of these may see the light of day and some may not. One of the most interesting proposals was made to me by a young couple in the parish who remember being in a parish where the pastor said he would shave his head if people paid enough money for that.

- A pesar de las muchas declaraciones de objetivos de las Naciones Unidas y a pesar de los grandes esfuerzos de algunos países, la educación sigue siendo tremendamente desigual entre la población mundial.
- Hoy día las migraciones internacionales son parte del desarrollo global. [...] La educación juega un importante papel en la integración de los hijos de inmigrantes por todo el mundo.
- La educación debe promover el desarrollo total de la persona humana, la dignidad humana y el fortalecimiento del respeto de los derechos humanos y las libertades fundamentales.
- En el contexto de la globalización, el respeto por la diversidad cultural y el mantenimiento de los elementos de la identidad cultural son esenciales en el proceso de educación.
- La educación comienza en el seno materno. Uno de los caminos más importantes hacia la educación superior es la participación mayor de las familias y las comunidades locales en la dirección de sus proyectos educativos.
- El papel de los maestros como agentes de la educación tiene que ser reconocido y apoyado por todos los medios posibles.
- La tecnología de la comunicación y la información ofrece oportunidades extraordinarias para la renovación de la educación, por la rapidez de la información, el acceso a conocimientos y su relativamente bajo costo.

Education for Equality

Last November, the Pontifical Councils for Science and Social Sciences held a workshop on globalization and education. The following are some of its final observations:

- Despite the many declarations and statements of objectives enunciated by the United Nations, education remains extraordinarily uneven within the world population.
- Today international migrations are part of global development. Education plays an important role in the integration of the children of immigrants worldwide.
- Education should aim at the full development of the human person and the promotion of the meaning of human dignity.
- In particular, in the context of globalization, respect for cultural diversity, and the preservation of the elements of cultural identity are essential in the education process.
- Education begins in the womb. One of the critical paths to higher education at the school level is the increased participation of families and local communities in the governance of their educational projects.
- The role of teachers as agents of education has to be recognized and supported by every possible means.
- Communication and information technology offers extraordinary opportunities for renewal of education because of its capacity to connect people, its ability to promote the accessibility of remote areas, its decreasing costs and the potential volume of information it can convey.
