From the Pastor,

I got a very interesting email this past week. It was a link to a story that Pope Benedict XVI had outlawed communion in the hand and standing for communion. It was filled with out of context quotes and truly outlandish history. I am writing about this because I think it is very important to understand how the officials of the church actually speak and teach.

Every year or so the Vatican, usually through the Congregation for Divine Worship, will issue a letter or instruction on various liturgical issues. A few years ago it finalized a whole new "General Instruction for the Roman Missal." This covered in detail all aspects of the Mass including receiving communion. When such an instruction comes out, the bishops of each country discuss it, and it is the responsibility of each local bishop to implement it. That has been done here in Idaho and throughout the world.

But there are always people who did not get what they want in the instruction from Rome, so they make up new rules that they do like. This email was an example of someone who does not like standing for communion or communion in the hand making up things and then sending them out as the word of the pope.

I am reminded of the story told by an American cardinal who, having just returned from Rome, was at a local church in his diocese when a woman came up and yelled at him, saying, "The pope wants you to stop having altar girls. He came to me in a vision two nights ago and told me so." The cardinal looked at the woman and said, "That's odd. The Holy Father and I had lunch yesterday in the Vatican and he said he was pleased that girls were serving Mass and also said he had never visited this state. You must have had a vision from the pope of some other church, not the Roman Catholic one."

There are all sorts of silly things on the internet about the church. It is best to pay attention to none of them; although I do admit that some are so outlandish they are truly humorous. Some years ago there was the story that Pope John Paul II had actually died in the attempt on his life in the early years of his reign and that for the last twenty years there was an imposter taking his place. The supposed proof was that after the assassination attempt the pope looked older than he did before it. The tragedy is that some people choose to believe such nonsense. When the church officially teaches something, we all hear it from direct and accurate sources.
