Aquel hombre obedeció. Se inclinó, recogió un puñado de guijarros y se los metió en el bolsillo. A la mañana siguiente, vio que los guijarros se habían convertido en diamantes, rubíes y esmeraldas. Y se sintió feliz y triste. Feliz, por haber recogido los guijarros; triste, por no haber cogido más. Lo mismo ocurre con la educación.
