I have been asked about the Prison and Jail ministries in the Catholic Church here in Idaho; about how they can help. The prison ministry is led by men and women volunteers. Sunday after Sunday we visit our brothers and sisters who have lost privileges of freedom and are locked up in the county jails and different state prison establishments. We take to them the Word of God, and we help them know and grow in their faith. We tell them that they remain members of the Church and that we do not forget them while they are going through their difficult times.

When someone offers to volunteer for this ministry, we take on the responsibility of explaining the process and preparation and the type of work that is to be accomplished. If for some reason you cannot go to the prisons, there are other ways to help; for example, you can pray.
