Esta semana la Iglesia celebra dos santos muy especiales: madre (27) e hijo (28). Estoy refiriéndome a santa Mónica y san Agustín. La Iglesia venera a santa Mónica, esposa y viuda, no sólo por darle vida corporal a uno de los más grandes santos de la Iglesia, sino también porque fue ella el principal instrumento del que Dios se valió para darle a éste la fe. Los fieles se encomiendan, desde hace muchos siglos, a las oraciones de santa Mónica, ya que es patrona de las mujeres casadas y modelo de las madres cristianas. Agustín nació el 13 de noviembre del 354 en Tagaste, al norte de Africa. En su juventud se dejó arrastrar por los malos ejemplos y, hasta los 32 años llevó una vida licenciosa, aferrado a la herejía maniquea. De todo esto habla en sus "Confesiones", que comprenden la descripción de su conversión y la muerte de su madre. Dicha obra fue escrita para mostrar la misericordia de Dios hacia un gran pecador que, por esta gracia, llegó también a ser un gran santo. El gran obispo san Ambrosio tuvo también un papel muy importante en la conversión de Agustín quien, en agosto del 386, anunció su completa conversión al catolicismo. San Ambrosio lo bautizó en la Pascua del 387. Murió el 28 de agosto del 430, a los 72 años de edad. Es uno de mis santos preferidos, a quien cito con frecuencia en mis homilias y en las pláticas espirituales.

This week the church celebrates two very special saints: Mother (27) and son (28). I am referring to St. Monica and St. Augustine. The Church venerates St. Monica, wife and widow, not only for giving corporal life to one of the greatest saints of the Church, but also because God worked through her to convert her son. The faithful have been devoted to the prayers of St. Monica for many centuries since she is the patron saint of married women and a model for Christian Mothers.


Augustine was born on November 13, 354 at Tagaste, Numidia, North Africa. In his younger years he was negatively influenced by bad examples and until his 32nd year he led a wild life, and was strongly devoted to the Manichaeian philosophy which taught of a struggle between good and evil and featured a lax moral code. He spoke of all of this in his "confessions", which is understood in the description of his conversion and the death of his mother. This was all written to show the mercy that God has upon a great sinner who became a great saint through God's grace. Saint Ambrose of Milan also played an important role in his conversion who declared a complete Catholic conversion in August of 386. St. Ambrose baptized him Easter of 387. He died on the 28th of August, 430 at the age of 72. He is one of my preferred saints, whom I cite often in my homilies and during my spiritual talks.

SATURDAY MORNING ADULT FAITH FORMATION

St. John's will again be offering Saturday morning adult faith formation on the second Saturday of the month. This year each month's presentation will focus on the Sacraments. This program is open to all parishes.

The first session is September 13, 2008 and the presentation will focus on Experiencing the Divine (Sacraments) in Human Life. The presenters will be Bobbi Dominick, Pastoral Associate for Ministry, and Jackie Hopper, Director of Faith Formation. Subsequent months will focus on all of the seven different sacraments, and speakers will include Fr. Henry Carmona, Fr. The first session will be at the Parish Office, 775 N. 8th Street. Subsequent sessions will be held in the Parish Hall below the Cathedral. We begin with a gathering at 9:00 am, the presentation begins at 9:30 and is completed by about 11:00 am.
