From the Pastor,

Today I want to update all of us on our construction. First of all, there should be three new windows in the church the week of September 1st. It has been our intention to only order the windows as they were paid for, but to be able to have the same glass in all of the windows we had to order all of the glass and all the windows at the same time. Thus we will have all eight of the new windows in by the end of construction. But only one of the windows has been paid for by a donation. The windows cost \$8,000 each, and it would be great if people would be able to donate that as a gift or a memorial tribute. I hope to continue to contact some of the children of old St. Mary's families and seek out a gift for their parents.

Secondly I am most pleased to announce that the dedication date for the church has been set. It will be at 7 PM on the evening of January 21, 2009. The dedication of a church is one of the complicated and beautiful liturgies in Roman Catholicism and it will take a lot of work and many people to do it well -- and in typical Saint Mary's style, we will do it well. It will be a great day.

One thing which will not be finished when the church is dedicated is the landscaping. That will wait until the spring of 2009, but the plans for it are very nice. There will be a plaza all along the State Street side of the church with room for gatherings. There will be a fence along the side walk giving us some privacy and to cut down on the sound from State Street. Monsignor Creegan's Rose Garden will be replanted at the edge of the plaza. Plans now call for the pavement of the plaza to be the bricks from the old rectory and from the church.

I am very grateful that the pledges which were made for the church continue to come in well. The most difficult part of the financing is the land we own on Bogart Lane is difficult to sell in today's market. But that is a problem we will solve.

During the next months as work continues on the new part of the church through the middle of the old church the temporary wall which forms the back wall behind the altar now will be moved and redone a couple of times. There will be times when we can see into the new space and times when we cannot. But basically we will continue to use the space we are in now until late December. Plans now call for us to be totally out of the church for only one weekend, the last Sunday of Advent. We will then have Christmas Mass in the full new church, but it will be very unfinished. We will have a temporary altar because we cannot use the new altar until it is dedicated on the 21st of January.

Los obispos de los Estados Unidos invitan a los católicos a que recen una novena por la vida, la justicia y la paz, como preparación para las próximas elecciones presidenciales de noviembre. Esta novena forma parte de la campaña episcopal para ayudar a los católicos a formar sus conciencias ante cuestiones de tipo político y social; y se espera que los ayude a entrar en un clima de oración y reflexión cuando se preparen para votar. La Conferencia Episcopal quiere ayudar a los católicos a sopesar cuestiones preelectorales "proveyendo un recurso de oración en la web que nos ayude a profundizar en nuestros valores compartidos y nuestra identidad como católicos". Los obispos ofrecen varias opciones para rezar esta novena de los "Ciudadanos Fieles". La primera es comenzar el 2 de septiembre y rezar durante nueve martes consecutivos, hasta el día de las elecciones. Una segunda opción es empezar la novena cualquier otro día de la semana y rezar el mismo días todas las semanas. La novena puede rezarse también en los nueve días consecutivos antes de las elecciones (como un novenario), empezando el 26 de octubre. The USCCB wants to support Catholics as they weigh pre-election issues and that "providing a prayer resource on the web can help us focus on our common values and identity as Catholics." The novena for faithful citizenship runs for nine days and can be used consecutively, one day each week, for nine days prior to the election, or "in any way that works best for a community or individual."
