El 4 de agosto la Iglesia celebra la festividad de San Juan María Vianney, Cura de Ars, patrono de los sacerdotes. Con este motivo quiero compartir con ustedes un intento de respuesta a la pregunta: ¿Qué se necesita para ser sacerdote? La respuesta más general es: 1) Que tenga vocación es decir, que se sienta llamado por Dios; 2) que sea aceptado por el obispo para prepararse en un Seminario y 3) que sea ordenado por el obispo.

A continuación presento extractos de una alocución que dirigió el Papa Juan Pablo II a los obispos filipinos, el 9 de octubre del 2003, a quienes recordó que el sacerdocio no es una carrera o una profesión, sino una vocación a los demás que permite comprender el celibato. Para que la iglesia cuente con sacerdotes concientes de su misión, pidió a los obispos prestar particular atención a la selección de los candidatos al sacerdocio. "Una vez que un candidato es seleccionado, comienza el proceso para prepararlo a ser un sacerdote bueno y santo". Para alcanzar este objetivo, se requieren cuatro "diversos niveles de formación": A) Formación humana, que ayuda al candidato a vivir e interiorizar las virtudes sacerdotales, especialmente la sencillez, la castidad, la prudencia, la paciencia y la obediencia; B) necesita el candidato formación intelectual, que subraya y profundiza en el estudio de la filosofía y la teología, man-

De este modo, concluye el Papa, se pueden formar "ministros que luchen gozosamente por ser fieles al Señor y por servir a su rebaño".

The Feast of Saint John Mary Vianney, Cure of Ars, is on August 4th. He is the patron saint of priests so I want to share with you an attempt to answer the question of what is necessary to be a priest. The most general answer is that it requires 1) to have a vocation, by this I mean he feels called by God; 2) to be accepted by the Bishop to attend Seminary; 3) to be ordained a priest by the Bishop.

I have presented below some extracts of Pope John Paul II's speech to the Philippine bishops on October 9th, 2003, where he reminded them that the priesthood is not a career or profession but a vocation of love for others, which allows the understanding of celibacy. He asked bishops to pay special attention to the selection of aspirants to the priesthood so the Church can have priests who understand their mission. "Once a candidate is chosen, the process to train him to be a holy, good priest starts".

In order to achieve this objective, four "different educational levels" are required: A) values oriented instruction that helps the candidate to live out the priesthood virtues, especially simplicity, chastity, prudence, patience and obedience; B) intellectual schooling outlining and deepening the study of philosophy and theology according to the teachings of the Church; C) pastoral education that enables aspirants to apply the theological principles to the pastoral practice; and D) spiritual practice, highlighting the essential need for a regular observance of the sacraments, as well as private and devotional prayer and frequent meetings with his spiritual director. In this way, the Pope concludes, ministers who will strive joyfully to be faithful to the Lord in serving his flock can be developed.
