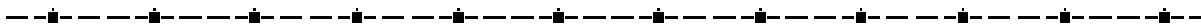
Gracias a todas las personas que han trabajado duro para lograr un Adviento muy bueno para todos nosotros.

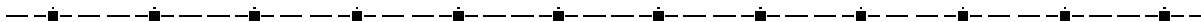
