### PASTORS' PAGE

El 5 de febrero de 1597 fue martirizado quien ahora veneramos como San Felipe de Jesús. Había nacido 24 años antes en la ciudad de México, bajo el nombre de Felipe de las Casas. En su niñez se caracterizó por su índole inquieta y traviesa. Se cuenta que su aya, una buena negra cristiana, al comprobar las diarias travesuras de Felinillo, solía exclamar, con la mirada fija en la higuera seca que había en el fondo del jardín: "Antes la higuera seca reverdecerá, que Felipillo llegue a ser un santo..." Vivió un tiempo en Manila, Filipinas. Allí encontró su vocación y entró a la Orden de los franciscanos. Terminada su formación y por un privilegio especial le concedieron el ir a ordenarse a México. Se embarcó junto a otros franciscanos rumbo a la Nueva España. Pero una gran tempestad los arrojó a las costas del Japón. Fueron hechos prisioneros y luego llevados en procesión por varias ciudades para que se burlaran de ellos. Finalmente en Nagasaki, en compañía de otros 21 franciscanos fueron atados a una cruz. Felipe se abrazó a la cruz y murió atravesado por dos lanzas. Felipe fue el primero en morir. Sus últimas palabras fueron: "¡Jesús, Jesús, Jesús!"

San Felipe de Jesús was martyred on February 5, 1597. He was born 24 years before in the city of Mexico under the name of Felipe de Las Casas. In his childhood, he was characterized by his restless anxiety. It is said that his nanny, a good black Christian woman, would confirm the daily mischief that little Felipe caused. She would exclaim, as she had her sight fixed on the dry fig tree that was located at the end of the garden: "the fig tree will turn green again before little Felipe will become a saint..." He lived for a little while in Manila, Philippines and it was there that he found his vocation and entered the Franciscan order. When he was finished with his formation, and because of a special privilege, they allowed him to be ordained in Mexico. He joined other Franciscans on a ship headed to the New Spain but a great storm detoured them to the coast of Japan. They were made prisoners and then taken by procession to various cities so that they would be ridiculed. Finally in Nagasaki, accompanied by 21 other Franciscans they were tied to a cross. Felipe embraced a cross and died crossed by two spears. Felipe was the first to die. His last words were: "Jesus, Jesus, Jesus!"
