## FROM THE PASTOR

It has been a long and interesting year at Saint Mary's. There have been some truly sad and tragic moments, some great moments, and a great deal of God's grace and goodness has been shared.

The year began with my continuing recovery from an accident and the need for hand surgery. Everyone picked up the pieces so well and took such good care of me. I was so fortunate to have an outstanding doctor [a member of the parish] and outstanding therapist [a member of the parish] and so many people who helped me.

I finally was able to take a little time off, only to have Father Miller have a seizure the day I left. He recovered for the most part, but eventually he needed to get a full check-up and has been at his hospital in Pennsylvania since September. He will be home soon. He has been deeply missed, but he will come back to us better than ever.

The tragic death of our beloved Father Raymond Jarboe was a terrible blow to all of us. His loss has hit us hard, but the beautiful and deeply spiritual response of all the parish has been awesome. Father Ray is proud of all of us.

The Saint Mary's Food Bank, one of the Jewels in our Crown, continues to grow, both in donations, time given, financial support, and the number of clients served. This has led us to a new building and there will be an official "Open House" and blessing later this month. Thanks to all of those who do so much for and with our Food Bank.

Saint Mary's School, our other Crown Jewel, continues to grow and prosper, with enrollment at the highest in years and continuing to grow. The cultural diversity is so great and the education is outstanding. Most of all, it is a deeply spiritual atmosphere and one that brings the best of our Catholicism to all who come in contact with the staff, students, teachers, and parents. We are so blessed in Saint Mary's School.

For me personally, it has been a better year in regard to my health, but I do have to continue to be very careful. I celebrated my 40th anniversary of ordination last June and I thank all of you who made that such a great experience. This fall I finished two more books and got them published. I still have about seven manuscripts which I hope to work on and finish one of these days.

We continue to have the best parish staff in the world, even though I admit that we are sort of a "motley crew." All of the staff continues to be with us, and we added a new deacon, Bernie Rekiere, who is a great addition to our family.

It has been a great year for all the parish, with great events for the English speaking part of our community and the Spanish speaking part of our community.

As for the future, 2012 is the 75th anniversary of Saint Mary's Parish. It is going to be a wonderful and busy year. God is so good to us. ~ Father Tom Faucher, Pastor

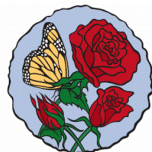

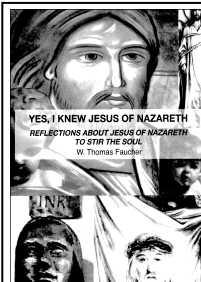

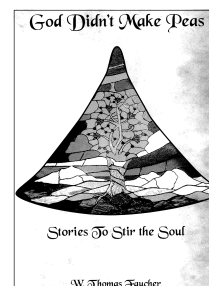
