Father John J. Creegan came to Boise without a church or a rectory in the fall of 1937. The church was soon to be finished and was dedicated [not consecrated] on December 19, 1937 by Bishop Edward J. Kelly. But Father Creegan had to live on the third floor of the Cathedral rectory until the rectory of Saint Mary's was finished in the summer of 1938.

He had a daunting job before him, and he set to work making a new parish happen.

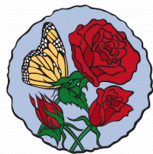

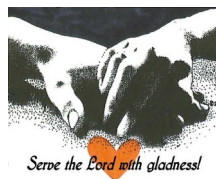
