El Quinto Mandamiento—**No matarás**

La semana pasada fue el 39° Aniversario de un triste y desafortunado evento, en el cual un grupo de personas sin valores morales convencieron a la corte suprema del gobierno en la legalización del aborto; esta ley otorgada esta rotundamente en contra del 5° Mandamiento de Dios. La enseñanza de la Iglesia Católica, nos dice: "La vida humana es sagrada, porque desde su inicio es fruto de la acción creadora de Dios y permanece siempre en una relación con el creador hasta su término: Nadie en ninguna circunstancia, puede atribuirse el derecho de matar de modo directo a un ser humano inocente" (CIC2258). El aborto directo, es decir, querido como un fin o como un medio, es gravemente contrario a la ley moral (CIC2271) Oremos para que Dios tenga misericordia por los que cometen este delito y llegue a su fin esta ley.

The Fifth Commandment—**you shall not kill**

Last week was the 39th Anniversary of an unfortunate, sad event in which a group of non-moral valued people convinced the U.S. Supreme Court in the decision Roe vs. Wade for abortion. Besides its disastrous decision, it goes against God's 5th Commandment. The Church's teaching is: "Human life is sacred because from its beginning it involves the creative action of God and it remains forever in special relationship with the Creator, who is its sole end. God alone, is the Lord of life from its beginning until its end: No one, under any circumstances, can claim for him/herself the right directly to destroy an innocent human being". (CCC2258) "Since the First Century, the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion. This teaching has not change and remains unchangeable. Direct abortion, that is to say, abortion willed either as an end or means, is gravely contrary to the moral law: "You shall not kill the embryo by abortion and shall not cause the new born to parish". (CCC2271)

Let us pray for God's mercy for all those who commit this crime, and for the end of this law.

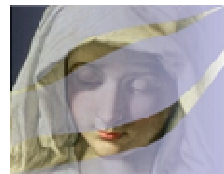

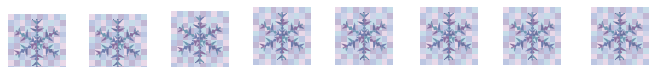
