When I contemplate what the Mass means to me I always get goose bumps. Goose bumps because it is an overwhelming feeling of joy and mystery that fills me in anticipation of the next time that I will receive my Lord and be filled with His magnificent presence; the awe inspiring possibility of being closer to Him; and for the opportunity to be Eucharist to all those I come into contact with. To hear His message in the gospel and to receive Him bodily into my life completes me as a Christian.

For those of our sisters and brothers who cannot be at the Mass, there is often a feeling of terrible loss. Loss in not experiencing the opportunity to be filled with the real presence of Jesus, not hearing the word of God proclaimed, and the genuine loss of community by not being able to join other members of their faith community in that experience.

The *Eucharistic Outreach Ministry* at St. Mary's brings the Eucharist to the homebound and the care facilities within our parish boundaries. Your fellow parishioners take time to be there for members of our faith community who cannot fully experience Christ at the Mass. This outreach brings Catholic residents of the care facilities together in communion with Christ by bringing them the word of God and the blessed sacrament that has been consecrated at the Mass. Outreach ministers also take the word and blessed sacrament to the homebound; offering their personal friendship and caring in the process.

All of us as Christians are called to love, care, and live a life of service and mercy. Some of you may be called to a deeper level of service and compassion; to be the vehicle by which a fellow parishioner feels that tingling, joyous feeling of knowing they will be part of that magnificent communion with Christ. If you think you may be called to such ministry, and for as little as two hours per month, please contact me to meet and discuss the wondrous possibilities.

Estos religiosos le tenían una gran devoción a la Santísima Virgen y le construyeron un templo en ese lugar. A Chile llegó esta devoción en 1680, traída por los misioneros agustinos.

To this mount the prophet Elijah retired to pray. Many centuries ago, several monks gathered to pray and do penance. People called them "carmelites." Those brothers had a deep devotion to the Holy Virgin and built her a temple in the beautiful mountain. This devotion came to Chile in 1680, brought by Augustinian missionaries.

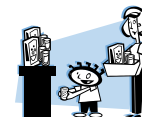
