My Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

With construction set to begin to renew our church building, St. Mary's is also moving forward in its efforts to serve our parishioners and the greater community in our geographic area. The Gospel messages of the last two Sundays speak with great clarity to the need for service within the Christian community.

Last Sunday's Gospel of Luke focused on Jesus sending forth the 72 disciples to stay with the people, eat with them and heal the sick. When they returned from their work with joy, they were excited that even the demons submitted to them in Jesus' name. Jesus gently admonished them that they must keep the kingdom of God in sight and they should rejoice only because their name shall be written in heaven.

We too have the opportunity to have our name written in heaven; simply by following our Lord's mandate to love one another by offering and accepting hospitality and "heal the sick." There are many different types of sickness; sickness of the body, sickness of the mind and sickness of the soul. But we have many different gifts to offer in the healing process. We are truly one body with many gifts.

At this time 8 parishioners are needed to serve 1 ½ hours per month at one nursing home in our district. This is an opportunity for St. Mary's parishioners to reach out. St. Mary's has several ministering angels that currently serve the nursing homes in the Eucharistic outreach program. We are in process of augmenting their efforts by offering communion services on Sundays. This has proven successful at one nursing home within our boundaries. We now are ready to begin another. Volunteers need special gifts of caring, confidentiality, listening, patience, and a deep interest in serving the Lord in this special ministry. The spiritual rewards are many in addition to your "... name written in heaven." Training is provided.

In this Sunday's Gospel message Luke again makes it clear what must be done to inherit eternal life. In a nutshell we are to love God with all our soul, all of our strength, and with our entire mind and to love our neighbor as ourselves. Jesus expounds on that with the parable of the Good Samaritan which clearly tells us that our neighbor is anyone of any race, creed or social background who is in need. Love then, is acting to meet their needs. Stephens Ministry at St. Mary's does this work in a confidential caring ministry. The ministry also reaches out to the larger community out side of St. Mary's.

Linda Leonard and Darcy Amburn have been leaders in the Stephen Ministry for many years and have been catalysts in moving the ministry forward. In the near future we hope this ministry will be expanded. Many additional care givers may be needed. This will be another opportunity to serve. Special gifts are also needed for this ministry coupled with 50 hours of training. In the coming weeks please look for the announcement in the bulletin seeking volunteers who agree to an application and screening process.

In the meanwhile, please pray for clarity regarding your own gifts and for discernment to determine where God wants you to serve.
