From the Pastor,

It has always been one of my goals at Saint Mary's to have a SHARING TABLE. We have not had one because there was no room in the old church, but now we can. A Sharing Table is simply a table at the entrance to the church where people who have extra garden goods can leave them, and people who want produce can pick it up. In my experience it works very well. During the summer the table is usually filled and then usually emptied. It is especially good for people who once had a garden and do not have one now.

The Sharing Table is up this week just inside the front door. Please feel free to put things on it, and to take things. I do ask that no one take so much from the table that others do not have a chance. I am looking for someone to take this project on and sort of run it. If you would like to do that, please call the office.

Just a couple of other items: The next angel should be here in early August. It is probably going to be the one holding the mandolin and will be placed on the last beam on the left side of the church as you face the altar. Also we continue to work on having a Mass in Swahili once a month beginning in September. We are also working on having the 5 p.m. Mass on Saturday be a Youth Mass some of the time.

### Responsibility as Citizens(1)

As the general elections approaches, the Conference of U.S. Bishops has proposed some issues to be considered before we cast our ballots in November. They offer some interesting points that could be applied mentally to every candidate's platform when deciding who responds better to our aspirations and convictions. Some of the topics for reflection are based on seven basic ideas:

1. The right to life and dignity of every human being. Life, the bishops say, is threatened by abortion, euthanasia, cloning, and destruction of human embryos for research.
2. The call to the family, the community and participation.
3. The rights and responsibilities of human beings, such as the right to life, to religious freedom, housing, education, health care and employment.
4. Opting for the poor and most vulnerable: the unborn, those with disabilities or illnesses, the poor and marginalized.
5. Dignity of work and rights of workers.
6. Solidarity: Our commitment as Catholics demands that we seek justice, eliminate racism and human trafficking, protect human rights, seek peace, and avoid the use of force.
7. Caring for God's creation. Caring for the earth is an obligation of our Catholic faith. We are called upon to be good administrators and ensure a sound environment for humanity now and in the future.

Ante las próximas elecciones generales en Estados Unidos, que se celebrarán a principios de noviembre, la Conferencia de Obispos de los Estados Unidos propone algunos temas sobre los que pensar antes de acercarse a las urnas. Ofrecen algunos puntos interesantes que se pueden hacer mentalmente a cada plataforma para decidir qué candidato responde mejor a nuestras propias aspiraciones y convicciones. Algunos de los temas para la reflexión se basan en siete áreas básicas:

1. Derecho a la vida y la dignidad de la persona humana. La vida, dicen los obispos, está amenazada por el aborto, la eutanasia, la clonación, y la destrucción de embriones para la investigación.
2. La llamada a la familia, la comunidad y la participación.
3. Los derechos y responsabilidades de los seres humanos, como el derecho a la vida, a la libertad religiosa, la vivienda, educación, cuidados de salud y empleo.
4. Opción por los pobres y más vulnerables: los no nacidos, quienes tienen discapacidades o enfermedades, los pobres y marginados.
5. Dignidad del trabajo y derechos de los trabajadores.
6. Solidaridad. Nuestro compromiso católico exige que busquemos la justicia, eliminemos el racismo y el tráfico humano, protejamos los derechos humanos, busquemos la paz y evitemos el uso de la fuerza.
7. Cuidado de la creación de Dios. El cuidado de la tierra es un deber de la fe católica. Se nos llama a ser buenos administradores y a asegurar un buen medio ambiente para la humanidad.
