Se traduce a veces como "arrepentirse", pero el significado original va mucho más allá. "Metanoia" significa hacer un cambio positivo en nuestras vidas y en nuestra sociedad. Es algo así como dar un paso adelante para mejorar nuestra vida y nuestra sociedad. Es pues un cambio positivo que nos acerca un poco más a lo que Dios tenía en mente en el momento de la Creación. Si intentamos una traducción más precisa de la palabra "metanoia", encontramos que "meta" en griego significa literalmente "con"; y "noia" significa "comprensión, entendimiento". Por lo tanto no es cambiar por cambiar, sino un cambio positivo con una profunda comprensión de sus consecuencias. Pienso que esto es precisamente lo que estamos intentando en nuestra parroquia: un cambio positivo para seguir creciendo física y espiritualmente.

A piece of St. Mary's history is leaving this Sunday. Of course, to see the old rectory leave, more than one tear will fall from our eyes with a feeling of sadness. This is true and very human. But at the same time we will be thinking about the start of a new phase of growth. This is similar to when a child has grown and he must put aside his old pants in order for him to put on new ones, because he has grown! The emphasis is on that he has grown and that is why he needs new pants. As I reflect on the importance this event has on our community, the Greek word "metanoia" comes to mind. This word is used quite frequently in the writings of the New Testament. Jesus uses it in the first announcement of the coming of God's Kingdom (Marcos 1:14). It translates sometimes like "regret", but the original meaning goes beyond that. "Metanoia" means to make a positive change in our lives and in our society. It is something like how to take a step forward to better our lives and our society. It then is a positive change that draws us closer to what God had in mind during the time of the Creation. If we take a more precise translation of the word "metanoia", we find that in Greek "meta" literally means "with" and "noia" means "understanding". Therefore change is not to just change but it is about a positive change with a profound comprehension of the consequences. I believe that this is precisely what we are trying to do at our parish: a positive change so we can continue to grow physically and spiritually.
