La vida de familia, o en familia, es lo más cercano a la vida de Dios. Nuestro Dios es una familia y nosotros fuimos creados a su imagen y semejanza; es decir, fuimos hechos para vivir en familia. La vida en familia comienza desde nuestro nacimiento y no termina nunca; porque cuando acaba nuestra etapa terrena, nacemos a la vida definitiva, la eterna, para vivir en perfecta y alegre comunión con nuestro Dios. Tan importante es la familia que la salvación misma avanza en esa dirección. En efecto, el proyecto de salvación trazado por nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo consiste en crear, alimentar y encabezar la formación de un pueblo que poco a poco se vaya convirtiendo en una familia, que llamamos Iglesia: "Que todos sean uno como Tú y Yo, Padre, somos Uno" (Jn 17,21).

Hago un llamado a los padres de familia a intentar por todos los medios al alcance el promover la vida de familia: comer juntos, jugar juntos, rezar juntos, acudir a la Iglesia juntos. It gives an impression that the gathering of family members happens when there is limited time left over. I invite all of the parents of families to make every intention possible to promote a family life: eating together, playing together, praying together, and going to church together. Summer vacation is a wonderful time to take advantage of this opportunity.
