From the Pastor,

There are many, many things happening here at Saint Mary's. This weekend we will have 68 First Communion children at a 2:30 p.m. Mass. We had another large number of First Communion children the first week of May. We had two Confirmation ceremonies with almost 40 young people receiving that sacrament. In the last few weeks we have had over 20 baptisms.

We had graduation for high school students from the 8 high schools our students go to, and graduation at Saint Mary's School as well.

All of this is going on while I am still not totally well, our Administrative Assistant Marisela Baca is also out on medical leave, and the parish offices have been moved to the old convent. The old rectory building is getting ready to be physically moved to 27th and Woodlawn Sts. That will take place before the end of the month.

This coming week 26th street will be closed as they move the sewer from going through our land to going around our land. At the same time the small street in front of the church and school will continue to be closed for those working on moving the old rectory building.

I want to take this opportunity to thank the Knights of Columbus for taking care of all the bricks removed from the old rectory. It took over 150 human hours with dozens of volunteers to get all the bricks off the grounds and into storage. The plan is for the best of the bricks to be made available to the parish members to purchase as memory pieces for the old church and rectory. Other bricks will be available to be bought as pavers or to use in projects. All of those details are being worked out and will be announced soon.

I thank the Knights of Columbus for all they have done and all they continue to do. We are so fortunate to have such good people.

The adventures of building our new addition to the church are just beginning. It is going to be an interesting and exciting year.

Hay muchas, muchas cosas que están pasando aquí en Santa María. Este fin de semana vamos a celebrar 68 primeras comuniones durante una misa especial a las 2:30 p.m. Se llevo acabo otra gran cantidad de primeras comuniones durante la primera semana de mayo. Aproximadamente 40 jóvenes recibieron el sacramento de la confirmación en dos ceremonias. En las últimas semanas hemos tenido más de veinte bautizos.

Las graduaciones de los estudiantes de la preparatoria de las ocho escuelas que asisten nuestros estudiantes, y también la graduación de los estudiantes de la escuela de Santa María.

Todas estas cosas esta sucediendo mientras yo todavía no estoy completamente bien de salud, nuestra asistente administrativa Marisela Baca también esta fuera de la oficina por razones medicas, y la oficina parroquial fue movida a la casita . Están preparando el edificio donde estaba la oficina para físicamente ser movida a la calle 27 esquina con la calle Woodlawn. Esto se llevara acabo antes de que se termine el mes de junio. La siguiente semana la calle 26 estará cerrada en lo que mueven la alcantarillada que corre a la mitad de nuestra propiedad alrededor de nuestra propiedad. Al mismo tiempo la callecita en frente de la iglesia y la escuela se mantendrá cerrada para los que están trabajando en mover el edificio donde se ubicaba la oficina.

Quiero tomar esta oportunidad para agradecer a los Caballeros de Colón por hacerse responsables de acomodar los ladrillos retirados del edificio donde se ubicaba la oficina. Se tomo más de 150 horas de trabajo de docenas de voluntarios para juntar todos los ladrillos y moverlos de la propiedad a un almacenaje. El plan es que los mejores ladrillos se harán disponibles a los miembros de la parroquia para comprarlos como un recuerdo de la iglesia y el edificio donde se ubicaba la oficina. Otros ladrillos estarán disponibles para ser comprados para ser utilizados para hacer una vereda o para ser utilizados en otros proyectos. Todos los detalles están siendo planeados detalladamente y serán anunciados próximamente.

Les ofrezco las más sinceras gracias a los Caballeros de Colón por todo lo que han hecho y siguen haciendo por la iglesia. Somos muy afortunados de tener gente tan buena. Las aventuras de construir nuestra iglesia apenas van comenzando. Va ser un año muy interesante y emocionante.
