PASTORS' PAGE

Ha terminado nuestro curso de catecismo de preparación a los sacramentos de la Reconciliación y de la Eucaristía. Cerca de 60 niños y adolescentes han venido preparándose y ya están listos para recibir la Primera Comunión el próximo domingo, con el favor de Dios. Quiero aprovechar este espacio para intentar una breve explicación de nuestro programa de catecismo. Se trata de un programa adaptado a las necesidades específicas de la comunidad hispana. Es un curso intensivo de tres meses completos, con clases cada domingo con duración de dos horas. El contenido del curso ha sido diseñado por este servidor con la ayuda del equipo de catequistas. El objetivo del curso es conectar el aprendizaje de las verdades de la fe católica con la vida familiar y las celebraciones parroquiales (conocer, celebrar y practicar nuestra fe). Por lo tanto, la participación de los papás juega un papel muy importante para el éxito del programa. Los papás firman un documento, al momento de inscribir a sus hijos, por el cual se comprometen a traer a sus niños sin falta cada domingo y a asistir a Misa todos los domingos durante el tiempo de preparación. Además aceptan acudir a las reuniones especiales a las que se les cita para explicarles más en detalle el programa, su participación y detalles a tomar en cuenta, sobre todo los de carácter cultural y familiar, para la celebración de los sacramentos. Ellos ayudan a sus hijos en las tareas encomendadas por las catequistas. Pero sobre todo se les ayuda a aceptar la responsabilidad de seguir acompañando el crecimiento de la fe de sus hijos. A los estudiantes se les entrega la Biblia desde la primera clase para que vayan sabiendo que las verdades de nuestra fe están cimentadas y enraizadas en la Biblia. Se les pide una participación en la clase y una relación respetuosa con sus catequistas y con sus compañeros/as. El equipo de catequistas ha sido especialmente capacitado para este programa. Quiero felicitar y agradecer al equipo de catequistas integrado por Genoveva y Gloria Muñoz, Isabel Aguilar, Rosy Carrillo, Dora Barroso, Gerardo Madrigal y Nancy Ruiz. Gracias también a los papás por su notable cooperación y a la parroquia de Santa María por su generoso apoyo.

We have finished our catechism classes in preparation for the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist. Approximately 60 children and adolescents have been preparing and are ready to receive their First Communion next Sunday, God willing. I would like to take advantage of this space to try to give a brief explanation of our catechism program. This program is adapted to the specific needs of the Hispanic community. It is a three month long intensive course with classes being held every Sunday for two hours. The course content has been designed by your servant with the help of the team of catechists. The objective of this course is to relate the learning of the true catholic faith with the family life and the parish celebrations (know, celebrate and practice our faith). Consequently, the participation of the parents plays an important role for the success of this program. The parents sign a document at the time of registration in which they commit to bringing their children without missing a Sunday and attending Mass every Sunday during the time of preparation. In addition they accept to go to all of the special reunions scheduled to explain in more detail the program, their participation and details to take into consideration especially those that relate to cultural and family character to celebrate the sacraments. They help their children with their homework given by their catechists. But most importantly, the parents are aided in accepting the responsibility of following the growth of the faith of their children - The students are given a bible from the first class so that they are learning that the truths of our faith are founded and rooted in the bible. They are asked to participate in classes and a repeated relation with their catechists and with their fellow students. The team of catechists has been very capable to conduct this program. I would like to congratulate and thank the team of catechists coordinated by Genoveva and Gloria Munoz, Isabel Aguilar, Rosy Carillo, Dora Barroso, Gerardo Madrigal and Nancy Ruiz. Thank you also to the parents for their outstanding cooperation and to the parish of St. Mary's for your generous support.
