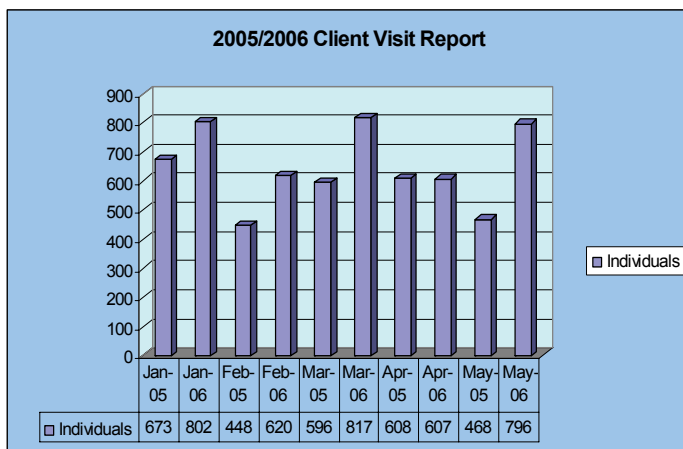

- #1) You must be actively registered as a family at St. Mary's by no later than June 30, 2006.
- #2) The family must be active in parish life by sharing their time, talents and treasure. Please note, the supporting pastors will verify registration and participation in their parish. They must approve the tuition support payment for each student or the tuition will be at regular rate.

In late August, Bishop Kelly will send us a list of the students who have listed St. Mary's as their parish. We are required to verify the name and activity level for each family. Please take the time to introduce yourself to Father Faucher, Father Miller, Father Camacho and other members of the parish staff. Let them be able to put a face to the name before this list arrives.

The families unknown to the office or parish staff will be denied as St. Mary's students, and will not be eligible for the tuition break.
