Las parroquias deben unir fuerzas

En una conferencia el Obispo Howard Hubbard de Albany, Nueva York, señaló algunos de los desafíos a las parroquias modernas. Entre otros, subrayó la tentación del parroquianismo, es decir, encerrarse en los confines de la parroquia. Dijo Hubbard: "Demasiadas parroquias se preocupan solamente de sus propias necesidades locales y no aprecian plenamente que son parte de una comunidad diocesana y de la iglesia universal y, por lo tanto, están llamadas a responder a las necesidades, preocupaciones y prioridades de la comunidad más amplia, más allá de la propia misión de la parroquia. Es decir, la parroquia debe vivir su misión como parte de la misión de la iglesia diocesana y universal, no como entidad separada y aislada.

La lucha contra el elitismo y aislamiento parroquial se hace significativa especialmente cuando se mira al desafío al que se enfrenta toda diócesis hoy día: Quien trabajará y servirá las parroquias a la luz del gran descenso de vocaciones al sacerdocio y la vida religiosa. Algunas parroquias tienen que cerrar porque ya no tienen una misión legítima. Pero incluso esas parroquias que aun son vitales y viables únicamente podrán sobrevivir si colaboran con las comunidades parroquiales vecinas coordinándose en de la misión, compartiendo recursos y personal y programando conjuntamente, por ejemplo, la preparación matrimonial, el ministerio juvenil, el funcionamiento de albergues y comedores sociales y los programas de servicio social".

Parishes must join forces

Speaking to a recent conference, Bishop Howard Hubbard of Albany, New York, underscored some of the challenges facing the modern parish. Among others, he emphasized the challenge of parochialism. He said: "Too many parishes are concerned only with their own immediate local needs and fail to appreciate fully that they are part of a diocesan community and the universal church, and hence are called to be responsive to the needs, concerns, and priorities of the wider community beyond the parish's own mission. The parish, in other words, must pursue its mission as part of the overall mission of the universal and diocesan church, not as a separate, isolated entity.

Combating this parochial elitism and isolationism becomes particularly significant, of course, in addressing the challenge facing almost every diocese today: staffing and serving parishes in light of the severe decline of vocations to the ordained and vowed life. Some parishes need to close because they no longer have a legitimate mission. But even those parishes that remain vital and viable will be able to survive only if they are willing to collaborate with neighboring parish communities in joint articulation of mission, in sharing personnel and resources, and in programming together, for example in marriage preparation, youth ministry, the operation of food pantries, and social service programs.
