New Realities of Hispanic Ministry*

Father Allan Figueroa Deck, SJ, executive director of the Secretariat of Cultural Diversity in the Church, speaking at a Symposium for researchers and pastoralists that was convened in October 2008 by the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate (CARA) of Georgetown University, emphasized that at this moment the Hispanic presence in the U.S Church has reached a critical number so as to become the most important indicator of the future of the Church.

Fr Deck went on to say that we are presently at a crossroad. There are various aspects to be considered as vitally important:

- The youth
- The fact that Hispanic ministry is not just confined to certain regions of the country
- The fact that Hispanic pastoral is in constant change and must be diversified and differentiated
- The fact that institutions and organizations in Hispanic ministry on a national and regional level have not achieved the vigor and effectiveness that are ideal for Hispanic ministry due to diverse difficulties of internal capacity and weakness.
- The presence of apostolic movements and their influence
- The ecclesial lay ministries
- The new resource of Hispanic/Latino theologians

In conclusion, Fr Deck highlighted the need to continually read the sign of the times, as well as having an ongoing and always renewing pastoral response.

Here's what ICA funds:

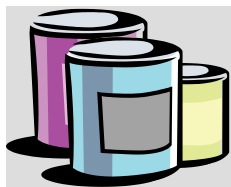
