From the Pastor,

I am gone this weekend, but I want to write about the Idaho Catholic Appeal collection which takes place now.

The Idaho Catholic Appeal Funds collected in our parish continue to come back to us in services. The Diocese is educating your future pastors with funds from the Idaho Catholic Appeal. Your retired pastors receive care through funds gifted to the Idaho Catholic Appeal. The Diocese also reaches beyond our borders to our National and Universal Church through the Idaho Catholic Appeal. Just as the Bible asks each of us to tithe, the Diocese designates 10% of the annual appeal directly to helping the poor.

For the past couple of years we have been slightly below our goal in the ICA because we were also collecting money for the renovation of the church. This year it is important that we truly step up to the plate and fulfill our goal even as we continue to collect money to pay for the new church.

Your check may be placed in the Pledge/Gift Envelope provided and placed in the offering during Mass. You may also return it to the parish office. Some families have asked me if we couldn't change the date of the Appeal because of financial circumstances. One could do that by gifting with a pledge and then making payments between now and December. You may also make a contribution by using your credit card or by Electronic Funds Transfer. I know these are very difficult times for many people. I know there are people who can give much less than they once did. But I do ask that people give something to the ICA. It is an expression of our ties with the universal church. Thank you.

El Viacrucis, Camino de la Cruz, Estaciones de la Cruz (los nombres son varios) es una de las devociones más populares durante el tiempo de Cuaresma. La mayoría de estas «estaciones» han sido tomadas del Evangelio, otras las ha deducido o añadido la tradición piadosa del pueblo cristiano. Las escenas o «estaciones» directamente descritas en los Evangelios son las siguientes:

- Primera: en Mt 27,1-31; Mc 15,120; Lc 23,1-25; Jn 18,28-40 y 19,1-16.
- Segunda: en Jn 19,17.
- Quinta: en Mt 27,32; Mc 15,21 y Lc 23,26.
- Octava: en Lc 23,27-32.
- Décima: en Mt 27,35; Mc 15,24; Lc 23,34 y Jn 19,23-24.
- Undécima: en Mt 27-25 s.; Mc 15,24 s.; Lc 23,33 s. y Jn 19,18.
- Duodécima: en Mt 27,50-51; Mc 15,37; Lc 23,46 y Jn 19,30-33.
- Décimo tercera: en Mt 27,57-59; Mc 15,42-45 y Lc 23,50-53.
- Décimo cuarta: en Mt 27,55-61; Mc 15, 42-47; Lc 23,50-55 y Jn 19,38-42.

Las otras estaciones –tercera, cuarta, sexta, séptima, novena– que ha añadido la tradición piadosa de los cristianos están relacionadas o deducidas de la descripción que los evangelistas hacen del camino que recorrió Jesús hacia el Calvario. Son posibles las caídas –estaciones 3ª, 7ª y 9ª, debido al agotamiento del Huerto, de los interrogatorios y sobre todo de las vejaciones –azotes, espinas– y episodios que acompañaron al arresto. Se deduce al menos una del hecho de haber pedido a Simón de Cirene que llevase la cruz, y se suponen lógicamente otras caídas, aunque no podamos saber el número exacto. Fue casi seguro el encuentro de Cristo con su Madre antes de la cruz (4ª estación), según Jn 19,25-27 y otros pasajes. Es muy probable el episodio de la Verónica según Lc 23,27 ss. y relatos escritos que se remontan a los siglos III y IV que pueden depender de relatos y tradiciones orales anteriores.
