PASTORS' PAGE

Las lecturas bíblicas de este segundo domingo de cuaresma nos invitan a una seria reflexión sobre la importancia de la virtud de la obediencia a la voluntad de Dios. Es necesario aprender a obedecer porque durante toda nuestra vida necesitaremos esta virtud. Cuando somos niños, debemos obedecer a nuestros padres en casa y a nuestros maestros en la escuela. En nuestros trabajos y en las organizaciones en las que participemos deberemos acatar las reglas y leyes de la empresa y las órdenes de la autoridad. Pero lo más importante de todo es que debemos aprender a obedecer a Dios, que es nuestro Señor y nos pide que hagamos Su voluntad, a ejemplo de nuestro Maestro Jesucristo, quien aprendió a obedecer hasta el punto de dar la vida por la humanidad en la Cruz.

La vida en familia puede ser (y debiera ser) la mejor escuela de aprendizaje de la virtud de la obediencia. Es una de las grandes tareas de los padres de familia, quienes lo prometen el día en que bautizan a sus hijos. Tenemos en la Sagrada Escritura grandes modelos: Abraham, quien por su obediencia se convirtió en el "padre de todos los creyentes"; María, quien por su "sí" a Dios nos consiguió la llegada del Mesías prometido; José, quien con su silenciosa obediencia se ganó la "confianza" de Dios hasta el punto de merecer la custodia de su Hijo y de su Madre. Dice el libro de los Proverbios que al que obedece, Dios le da la victoria. El tiempo de cuaresma nos brinda una magnífica oportunidad para avanzar en nuestro aprendizaje de obediencia a la voluntad de nuestro Dios y Señor. No la desaprovechemos.

The bible readings in this second Sunday of Lent invite us to reflect on the importance of the virtue of obedience to the will of God. It is necessary to learn to obey because we will need this virtue all of our life. When we are children, we should obey our parents at home and our teachers in school. In our work and in different organizations we belong to we have to follow the rules and laws of the organization and the instructions of those in authority. But the most important of all is to learn to obey God who is our Lord and Savior who asks us to do His will by using the example of our Teacher Jesus Christ who learned how to obey even to the point of giving up his life for humanity on the Cross.

The family life can be (and should be) the best environment for learning this virtue of obedience. It is one of the greatest tasks that parents take on when they have their children baptized. We have some great models of this virtue in our Sacred Scriptures: Abraham, who by his obedience was named the "father of all of the believers"; Mary, who by her saying "Yes" to God, earned the coming of the promised Messiah; Joseph, who by his silent obedience, earned the "confidence" of God to the point of earning the custody of his Son and His Mother. The book of Proverbs tells us that God gives the victory to the one who obeys. Lent gives us a great opportunity to advance in our learning of obedience to the will of God. Let us not miss this opportunity.

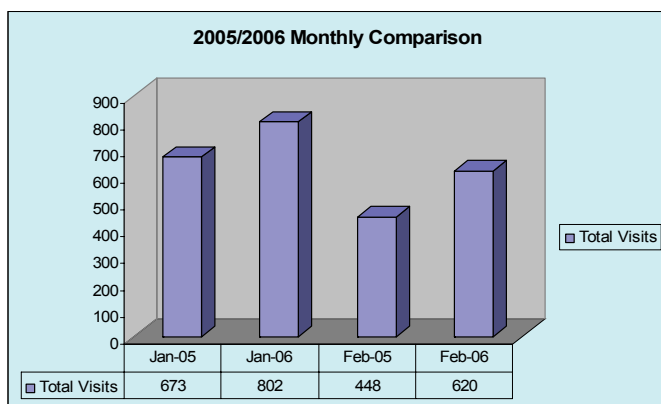

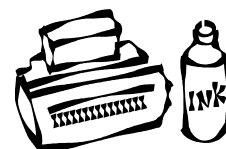

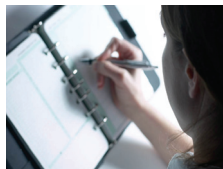
