From the Pastor,

It is my pleasure to congratulate the 26 children in the English speaking part of our community who are making their First Holy Communion this weekend. I thank Meg Lawless, Amy Foley, and all the teachers in Religious Education and Saint Mary's School who have prepared them so well. This is always a wonderful day.

In just over a month we will move from the old church into the new part of the building. When we do that, and maybe even before, we will remove all the Stations of the Cross, the statues, and all our other valuables from the church and put them into a secure storage area. While they are there, we have made arrangements for all the stations and statues to be professionally cleaned and if necessary repaired. [This is already being done with our nativity set.] In the temporary church we will be "camping out" a little, with concrete floors, the old pews set in place, but no kneelers. It will take some getting used to, but it will work well.

When the time comes for the move from the old church into the temporary one, we will need a lot of help moving things including the pews. We hope that many members of the parish will volunteer to help when the call goes out.

There are probably many questions that some of you may have so we have created an e-mail address for you to send in your questions and I will answer them and then they will be posted on the St. Mary's Website. Finally, today I want to talk a little about parish finances. At the present time, we have four main financial areas of parish life and all of them are in need of more money. The four are the regular parish operating finances, the parish Building Fund, St. Mary's School, and St. Mary's Food Bank. I am very proud and pleased with the way our finances are being regulated and served, but the bottom line is that all four areas are in need of additional money.

I would most sincerely ask that for those households who can afford to do so, the economic stimulus check which will be received from the government be donated to the parish. If you do that, you can state in the gift which of the four funds you want the money to go. I am donating my check to the parish and I know of a couple of families who have also told me they are doing it. I hope and pray for many more. But I emphasize that my suggestion is just for those who can afford to share this money with the parish -- not all of the parish can afford that.

We hope within a few weeks to have an "Open House" after all five Masses in the new part of the church so everyone can see it.
