From the Pastor,

First of all I wish all of you a Happy Mother's Day and a Happy Pentecost Day. I think this is the first time in almost 100 years that Pentecost has come on Mother's Day.

Secondly, I thank Benny Garcia and those who helped him in addition to all the others who have worked so hard on the new grass in front of the parish office. I also want to again thank Joe Records and all of those who helped plant the new roses.

As we come closer to moving into the temporary church, the back half of what will eventually be the whole church, I want to share more of what to expect. We are keeping the floor just concrete with the old pews bolted down to it. When we are all done we will remove the old floor, put tile in the aisles and carpet on the rest of the floor and then install the new bigger and more comfortable pews. In the temporary church we will not have kneelers, in the final church we will have new, fine [and thickly padded] kneelers. We will then put the old pews up for sale.

When they start the work on the old church we will also put the hanging lights up for sale. If you need a large hanging green shaded lamp, this is your chance.

The area around the interior doors from the narthex [lobby or gathering space] into the new church will not be done until we install the big 16 foot doors which go in the middle of that area. That will probably not be until October or November.


There will be a large cry room in the new church and it is in the part that is now getting done. But for the time we are in the temporary church, it will be used as the Blessed Sacrament Chapel and the Reconciliation Room. Our old beautiful tabernacle will be in storage and being cleaned and we will use the special tabernacle we use for Holy Thursday for the next 8 months.

We will move our present altar, pulpit and priest chairs over to the temporary church, but in the new church all of those will be replaced with new ones.

We will have bathrooms that work, air conditioning that works, and heating that works.

All of this will be both difficult and yet exciting.

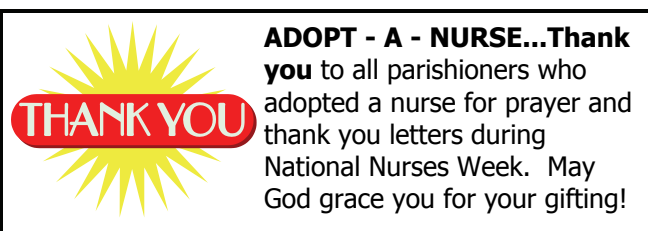
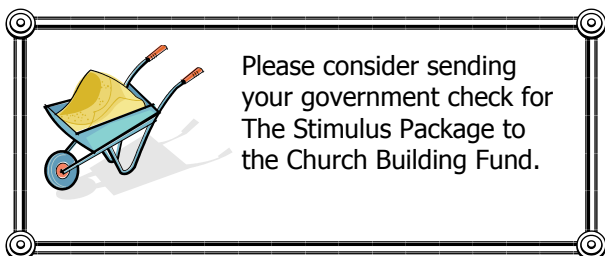

Día de la Madre. Sabemos que la madre juega un papel esencial en nuestra sociedad; pero de una manera todavía más notable en la cultura mexicana. La madre también está pasando por las situaciones difíciles y problemáticas que caracterizan a los inmigrantes. Por eso quiero invitarlos a que vayan a ver una película que se está exhibiendo aquí en la ciudad de Boise. Lleva el título de "Bajo la Misma Luna". (El título en inglés: "Under the Same Moon"). La película está hablada en español, con subtítulos en inglés y es apta para toda la familia. Está dirigida por Patricia Rikken y los protagonistas son Kate del Castillo, Eugenio Derbez, el niño Adrián Alonso, Carmen Salinas y una breve aparición de América Ferrara. El argumento es muy sencillo: el niño Adrián Alonso es el eje central de la cinta que cuenta una historia de desarraigo de una madre que se vino a Los Angeles en busca de trabajo, para enviar dinero a su familia: una madre enferma y un hijo "que no quiere más zapatos gringos, sino que quiere estar con su mamá aunque sea pobre". Es tan fuerte la nostalgia por su madre que el niño de 13 años se arriesga a venir a buscarla. Aunque la cinta se centra en una historia de inmigrantes indocumentados "lo que está por encima de todo es una historia de amor, un drama humano pero contado con mucho humor, con sentimientos universales que hace que esta historia sea universal". No deje de verla. Vale la pena. Felicidades a todas las madres de nuestra comunidad. Que Dios las llene de sus bendiciones este día y todos los días de su vida. ¡Felicidades!

Mother's Day. We know that a mother plays an essential role in our society; and yet in an even more notable manner in the Mexican Culture. A mother also goes through difficult and problematic situations that characterize immigrants. This is why I'm inviting you to go see the movie that is playing here in Boise. The title of the movie is "Bajo la Misma Luna". (The title in English is "Under the Same Moon"). The movie is in Spanish but it has English subtitles and it is appropriate for the whole family. It is directed by Patricia Rikken and the protagonists are Kate del Castillo, Eugenio Derbez, and the boy is Adrian Alonso, Carmen Salinas and a brief appearance by America Ferrara. The point is very simple: the little boy Adrian Alonso is the main character in the movie that tells a story of the uprooting of a mother who came to Los Angeles in search of work, to send money to her family: An ill mother and a son "who does not want gringo shoes, who wants to remain with his mom in spite of being poor". The 13 year old boy misses his mother so much that he takes a risk in coming to look for her. Even though the movie centers on undocumented immigrants "above anything else this is a story of love, a human drama told with much humor, universal emotions which makes this story a universal one". It is worth watching. Happy Mother's Day to all of the mothers in our community. May God fill you with blessings on this day and all of the days of your lives. Congratulations!

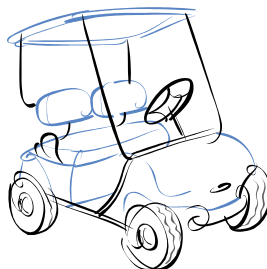
