During the next two weeks the moving company will begin to ready the old rectory for its move to the corner of 27th and Woodlawn. It will be a big event. The actual move will be sometime in the middle of June. It will take that long to cut the building from the foundation, hoist it up, secure the bricks, and get it ready.

In the meantime the work on the new sewer line will begin. This will mean a lot of construction on 26th street as they move the sewer line which runs through our property around the church. That will take until early August.

After so many years, we are finally at the point where the construction of our renewed and renovated parish church is beginning to happen. We also sold the "Stone House" farm on Castle Drive for a large profit, all of which goes into the building fund.

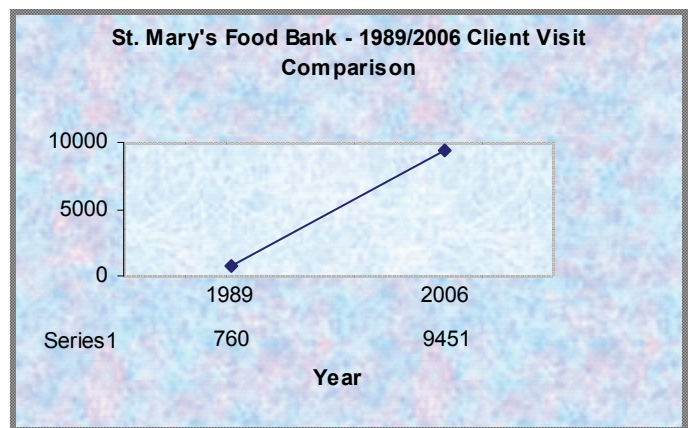
## ST. MARY'S FOOD BANK—RESULTS FOR APRIL & A BIT OF HISTORY!
