## PASTORS' PAGE

El viernes 17 de noviembre, con el favor de Dios, celebraremos la Primera Reconciliación de alrededor de 50 niños y jóvenes. Con este motivo, quiero hacer una breve reflexión sobre la importancia de este sacramento. Aun cuando una persona quiera desentenderse de Dios, el pecado pesa en su interior, no lo deja en paz. Hay que sacarlo para sentirse liberado. La situación de quien no "siente" el pecado es semejante a la del enfermo que ignora el cáncer que tiene dentro de sí. Parece ser que el drama del hombre de hoy no es tanto no necesitar el perdón de Dios cuanto no ser consciente de su pecado. El corazón humano es rudo y endurecido. Es preciso que Dios dé al ser humano un corazón nuevo (ver Ezequiel 36,26-27). La conversión es primeramente una obra de la gracias de Dios que hace volver a El nuestros corazones. Dios nos atrae por el amor infinito que Cristo ha mostrado a la humanidad. Todos sabemos que quizás la mayor necesidad humana es la de sentirse amado. Pues bien, el perdonar y el ser perdonado son la máxima manifestación del amor; y el saberse y sentirse perdonado es la expresión más elevada de ser amado. El sacramento de la reconciliación es un encuentro con Cristo. Así como los encuentros de la samaritana, de Zaqueo, de Pablo, etc., hay un algo que hace saltar la chispa de sentir a Dios como la medicina adecuada, la solución, el sentido de la vida, lo que andaba buscando, lo que más necesitaba. El pecador ante Dios no se siente descubierto sino perdonado. Ante Cristo Crucificado el pecador no debe sentir vergüenza sino amor. En el sacramento del perdón la miseria humana choca con la misericordia divina, el pecador y el redentor se abrazan, el hijo pródigo y el padre compasivo se vuelven a encontrar y se funden en un abrazo. Por la absolución sacramental del sacerdote, Dios concede al penitente "el perdón y la paz". La reconciliación con Dios trae como consecuencia, por así decirlo, otras reconciliaciones que reparan las rupturas causadas por el pecado: el penitente perdonado se reconcilia consigo mismo; se reconcilia con los hermanos ofendidos y lesionados por él/ella; se reconcilia con la iglesia y con toda la creación.

### SACRED HEART CATHOLIC SCHOOL HOLIDAY BAZAAR

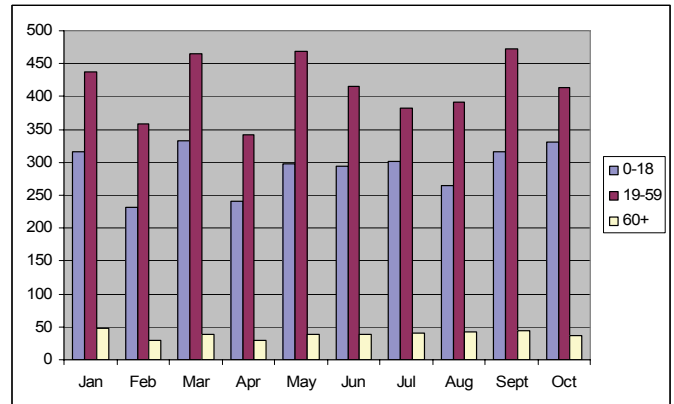
