Esta semana, la Iglesia celebra dos santos que quiero presentar a ustedes. El 11 es la fiesta de San Martín, obispo de Tours, mejor conocido como "San Martín Caballero". Es un santo muy querido por los franceses y muy popular en todo el mundo. Nació en Hungría (316-17), pero sus padres se fueron a vivir a Italia. Era hijo de un veterano del ejército y a los 15 años ya vestía el uniforme militar. Cuando era un catecúmeno (en preparación para recibir el bautismo), una noche vió en sueños que Jesús se le presentaba vestido con la mitad del manto que él había regalado a un pobre; y oyó que le decía: "Martín, hoy me cubriste con tu manto". Esta escena es la que aparece en la mayoría de las imágenes de este santo. Luego de esta visión, renunció a las armas y decidió seguir a Cristo en la vida religiosa. Fue obispo de Tours, en Francia. Gracias a su piedad, dedicación y milagros que obró, pronto desapareció el paganismo en esa región. Murió el 8 de noviembre de 397. Es el santo patrono de mi pueblo natal, San Martín de Hidalgo, Jalisco, México.

El 13 celebramos a Santa Francesca Saverio Cabrini (en italiano); Mother Frances Xavier Cabrini (en inglés); Santa Francisca Javier Cabrini o Madre Cabrini (en español). Nació el 15 de julio de 1850, en Italia; murió en Chicago, el 22 de diciembre de 1917. Es la patrona de los inmigrantes y la primera ciudadana estadounidense en ser canonizada. Llegó a Nueva York el 31 de marzo de 1889. Allí fundó el primero de los 67 orfanatos que fundó en varias ciudades de los Estados Unidos. En 1909 se nacionalizó estadounidense. Fue beatificada el 13 de noviembre de 1938 y canonizada el 7 de julio de 1946 por el Papa Pío XII. Una imagen suya estará en la capilla de los inmigrantes en nuestra iglesia de Santa María.

This week, the Church celebrates two saints whom I wish to present to you. The 11th is the Feast of Saint Martin, Bishop of Tours, better known as "Saint Martin the Gentleman". He is very well-loved by the French and is very popular worldwide. He was born in Hungary (316-17), but his parents left for Italy. He was the son of an army veteran and at 15; he already dressed in military uniform.

When he was a Catechumen (preparing for the reception of Baptism), he had a dream of Christ one night. In this vision, Jesus presented Martin with the very same cloak he gave to a poor person. He heard Christ say: "Martin,

today you covered me with your cloak." Of the majority of scenes attributed to Martin, this is the most popular. After this vision, Martin renounced the military and decided to follow Christ in the religious life. He was the Bishop of Tours, in France. Thanks to his holiness (piety), dedication and miracles, paganism soon disappeared from that region. Martin died on 8 November 397. He is the Patron Saint of my birth town, San Martín de Hidalgo, Mexico.

On the 13th, we celebrate Saint Francis Saverio Cabrini (in Italian), Mother Frances Xavier Cabrini (in English), Santa Francisca Javier Cabrini or Madre Cabrini (in Spanish). She was born on the 15 July 1850, in Italy. She died in Chicago on 22 December 1917. She is the patroness of immigrants and the first United States Citizen to be canonized. She arrived at New York on 31 March 1889. There she founded the first of 67 orphanages in various cities across the United States. In 1909, she became a United States citizen. She was beatified on 13 November 1938 and canonized on 7 July 1946 by Pope Pius XII. One of her images will be in the Immigrants Chapel in our church of Saint Mary's.
