Los cristianos de todos los tiempos hemos aprendido de María a amar y sufrir con su Hijo y por su Hijo. Oración: Señora y Madre nuestra: tú estabas serena y fuerte junto a la Cruz de Jesús. Ofrecías tu Hijo al Padre para la redención del mundo. Lo perdías, en cierto sentido, porque El tenía que estar en las cosas de su Padre, pero lo ganabas porque se convertía en Redentor del mundo, en el Amigo que da la vida por sus amigos. September 15th the church celebrates the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. (In Mexico it is celebrated a very popular way the Friday before Good Friday). Those who love, suffer with the loved. Nobody here on earth loved Jesus more than his mother; consequently nobody has suffered as she has. This feast celebrates the mystery and participation of Mary in the Life, Passion and Death of her Son. The Gospels and the Tradition speak of the "Seven Sufferings" of the Blessed Mother: 1) The prophesy of the old aged man named Simeon in The Presentation of Jesus (Luke 2, 22-35); 2) the Flight to Egypt (Matthew 2, 13-15); 3) The Boy Jesus in the Temple (Luke 2, 41-50); 4) Mary meets up with her Son on the way to Calvary (4th station in Stations of the Cross); 5) Jesus dies on the Cross (John 19, 17-39); 6) Mary receives the Body of Jesus as he's brought down off of the Cross and 7) The burial of Jesus (John 19, 38-42). As Christians, we have learned from Mary to love and suffer with Her Son and for her Son. Prayer: Our Blessed Mother: you were serene and strong by the Cross of Jesus. You offered your Son to the Father for the redemption of the world. You were losing him in a certain sense because he had to tend to His Father's business but you regained him because he redeemed the world by being the friend who gave his life for his friends. "Mary", how beautiful it is to hear from the Cross the words of Jesus, "there is your son", "there is your mother"! How great if we accept you into our homes like John! We want to always have you in our homes. Our home is where we live. But our home is especially our heart where the Holy Trinity resides. Amen.

September 16th is the day in which Mexico celebrates its independence. Our best wishes to all of the members of our parish whose country of origin is Mexico. Our prayers and affection are also with you. Congratulations!
