## PASTORS' PAGE

From the Pastor,

I know there are many important things to share with all of you. But before I get to those I feel I must share this news story.

An evangelist who tried replicating Jesus' miracle of walking on water has reportedly drowned off the western coast of Africa. Pastor Franck Kabele, 35, told his congregation he could repeat the biblical miracle, and he attempted it from a beach in Gabon's capital of Libreville. [ . . . ]

"He took his congregation to the beach saying he would walk across the Komo estuary, which takes 20 minutes by boat. He walked into the water, which soon passed over his head and he never came back."

I suppose what makes this story stand out for me is my strongly held belief that good religion is good mental health. The best test of whether or not a prayer, action or devotion is really good religion is what doing that thing will do for one's psychological state of mind. Religion can be and has been the cause of much suffering and illness over the centuries precisely because it was used to promote bad mental health.

Some examples of this are the persons who cease to think for themselves and turn over their minds to some guru or cult pastor; or the person who thinks God is speaking to them with messages that go against common sense and faith values [as in the story above]; or the person who makes devotions into superstitions.

Because Catholicism has so many devotions, saints and traditions the Church is very vigilant in trying to keep good religion as good mental health. All stories of visions, extraordinary events and things like that are viewed with great suspicion. Any prayers or actions which promise specific results are condemned. Anything which even hints of magic is rejected.

Good religion is good mental health.
