El 8 de septiembre la Iglesia celebra la fiesta de la Natividad (Nacimiento) de la Virgen María. Esta festividad es conocida en Oriente desde el siglo VI. Fue fijada el 8 de septiembre, día en que se abre el año litúrgico bizantino; el cual se cierra con la fiesta de la Dormición (Asunción), el 15 de agosto. En Occidente fue introducida hacia el siglo VII y era celebrada con una procesión-letanía, que terminaba en la Basílica de Santa María la Mayor. Los Evangelios no nos dan datos del nacimiento de María, pero hay varias tradiciones. Algunas, considerando a María descendiente de David, señalan su nacimiento en Belén. Otra corriente griega y armenia señala Nazareth como cuna de María. La fiesta tiene la alegría de un anuncio premesianico. Es famosa la homilía que pronunció san Juan Damasceno (675-749) un 8 de septiembre en la Basílica de Santa Ana: ¡Ea, pueblos todos, hombres de cualquier raza y lugar, de cualquier época y condición, celebremos con alegría la fiesta natalicia del gozo de todo el universo! Tenemos razones muy válidas para honrar el nacimiento de la Madre de Dios, por medio de la cual todo el género humano ha sido restaurado y la tristeza de la primera madre, Eva, se ha transformado en gozo. Esta escuchó la sentencia divina: parirás con dolor. A María, por el contrario, se le dijo: ¡Alégrate, llena de gracia"! Mis saludos y felicitaciones a todas las personas de origen cubano por la celebración de su Patrona, Nuestra Señora de la Caridad del Cobre.

On the 8th of September the Church celebrates the feast of the Nativity (Birth) of the Virgin Mary. This feast has been known in the East since the 6th century. It was established on the 8th of September, the date in which the Byzantine Liturgical year begins; therefore it ends with the feast of the Dormition (Assumption), on the 15th of August. In the West it was introduced in the 7th century and it was celebrated with a processional litany which ended in the Basilica of St. Mary the Major. The Gospels do not give us information about the birth of Mary but there are various traditions. Some, taking into consideration that Mary is a descendant of David, say that her birth place was Bethlehem. Another, Greek and Armenian opinion, is that her birthplace was Nazareth. The feast has the joy of a pre-messianic announcement. The famous homily proclaimed by St. John of Damascus (675-749) on the 8th of September in the Basilica of Santa Ana: All of you, people of all races and places, times and conditions, we celebrate with happiness the joyous birth of the entire universe! We have very valid reasons to honor the birth of the Mother of God, because through her, the human race has been restored and the sadness of the first mother, Eve, has been transformed to joy. The latter heard the divine sentence: You will give birth with pain. Conversely Mary was told: "Rejoice, full of grace"!

My greetings and congratulations to all of Cuban origin for the celebration of their Patroness, Our Lady of Charity of El Cobre.
